THE COURSE COVERS.

- State and comply with safety and legal requirements of a brush-cutter/trimmer, with an emphasis on safe practices, warning signs and guards
- State and identify the correct protective clothing to wear and the standards required
- Perform routine maintenance in accordance with the manufacturer's handbook
- Identify faults and defects on a brush-cutter/trimmer and decide which the operator can easily remedy, and which should be referred to a specialist engineer
- Identify which cutting head to select for the relevant operating conditions
- Carry out fuel mixing correctly and be able to start the brush-cutter/trimmer from both a hot and a cold condition in a safe manner
- Operate the brush-cutter/trimmer in a safe manner having regard for the safety of themselves, the public, property, and environmental factors
- Plan systematic working operations
- Use the manufacturer's instruction book and parts list
